

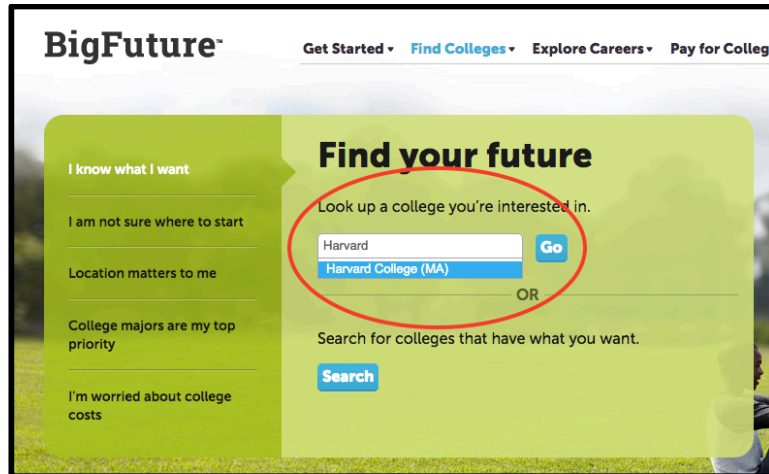

STEP 1

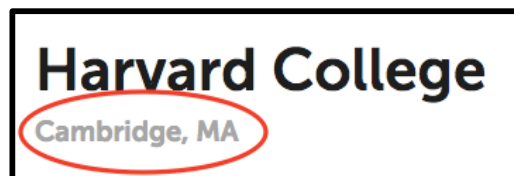
- Click on the link to **College Board College Search** on the course website.
- Type the name of the college or university in the search box.



- Choose the school name from the list.

STEP 2

On the school's information page, find the **city and state** at the top of the page.



STEP 3

- On the school's information page, click on the **Campus Life** tab on the left side of the page.

- Find the **setting** (urban, suburban, rural) and **Geographic Location** (distance to a major city downtown).
